- **21 September** - Results released

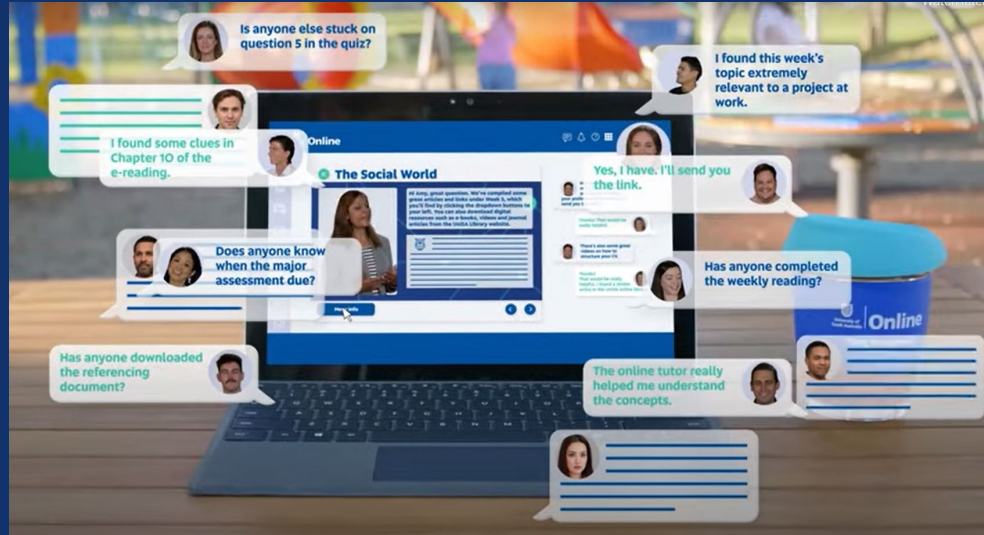

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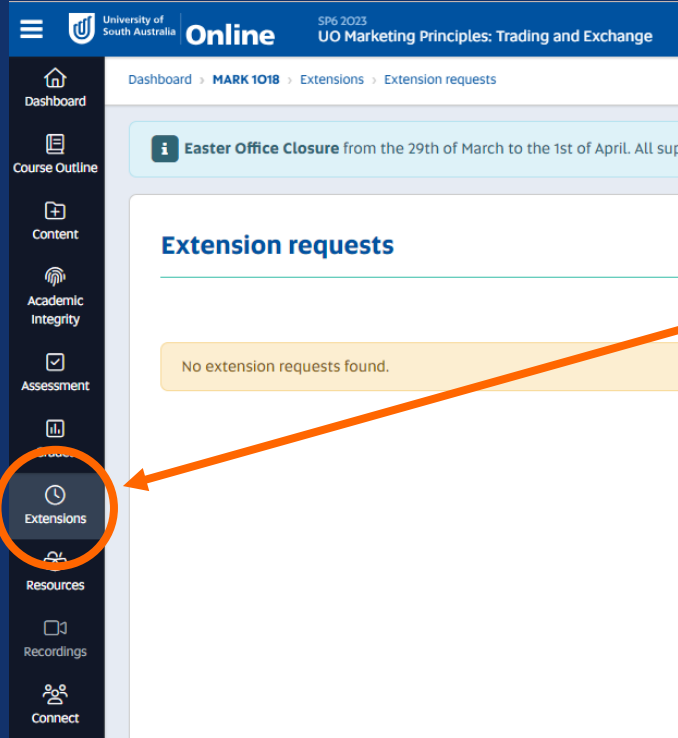

Online Exams

1. Check the exam timetable when it's released - **26 April (SP 3) & 29 July (SP 4)**
2. Ensure you're able to sit your exam on the **specified date and time** (if during school time, speak with your mentor to arrange a suitable examination space or permission to complete your exam at home)
3. Invigilated online exams are taken on your own computer, however regular exam conditions and rules still apply - this means you must be in a room on your own with no unauthorised materials present
4. You will need to complete the UniSA Online Exam Preparations Guide (**Access this via your LearnOnline dashboard, right hand column**)
